Annelies Zoomers is Professor of International Development Studies (IDS-development geography) at Utrecht University and Professor of International migration at the Radboud University of Nijmegen. After receiving her PhD in 1988, she worked as a researcher for the Netherlands Economic Institute in Rotterdam (1988-1992), and the Royal Tropical Institute in Amsterdam (1992-1995); during this period she worked for, among others, the World Bank, IFAD, DGIS, ILO, EU in various countries in Latin America, Africa and Asia. Between 1995 and 2007, she was associate professor at the Centre for Latin American research and documentation (CEDLA) in Amsterdam. She has published extensively about various development themes, including sustainable livelihood, land reforms, tourism and international migration. She was the coordinator of a research project on International migration and national development from a southern perspective, financed by the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2006-2007), and is member of the international advisory board (COS -AIV).
