Bram Huijsman (1951) is Director of Wageningen International comprising a centre focusing on training and advisory services for capacity development and institutional change (CD&IC) and a front office for the promotion of international collaboration of Wageningen University and Research Centre in the fields of education, research and capacity development.

Before coming to Wageningen in 2002, he was Director of ETC Foundation – an international think-tank advisory group in the field of sustainable development (agriculture, energy and health) - with its main office in Leusden and served as a Director of the Royal Tropical Institute in Amsterdam responsible for agriculture and small-scale enterprise development. Bram Huijsman completed his first degrees in development economics at Wageningen University before obtaining his PhD at the same university on the theme risk taking behaviour of small farmers.
