Fred van der Kraaij (1946) obtained a Ph.D. in economics from the University of Tilburg (with honours, 1983). His dissertation on the role of foreign investments in the development of Liberia 1900-1977 was published as "The Open Door Policy of Liberia – An Economic History of Modern Liberia" (Bremen, 1983). He wrote extensively on West Africa where he lived for over 16 years (Liberia, Burkina Faso, Mali, Senegal; 1975-91).

Since 1991 he has been working with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Netherlands, except for a two-year period during which he was employed by the World Bank, working for the Global Coalition for Africa (USA, 1999-2001). At present he works at the Policy and Operations Evaluation Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

His evaluation work includes amongst others the evaluation of the co financing between the Netherlands and the World Bank 1975-96; the evaluation of the Netherlands Research Policy 1992-2005; and the evaluation of the Netherlands Africa Policy, 1998–2006. His research areas are: the Dutch expansion overseas (Africa), Black people in the Netherlands in the 16th century, and the Political and economic history of Liberia.
