Greetings from Kyung Hee Univeristy.

Please allow me to introduce myself. I am Gon Khang Dean of the Office of International Affairs at Kyung Hee University (KHU). We are writing to inform you that we would like to give students of your country an opportunity to learn at our university. As you may know KHU is currently ranked 8th according to the JoongAng Daily University Rankings and 5th in the field of internationalization. You will find information about KHU attached to this letter. We are currently promoting scholarships to international students to enhance the understanding between nations through academic exchange which will ultimately promote KHU's position in the global academic society. KHU is willing to offer scholarships to international students depending on their academic performance. The qualifications and scholarship types are shown below.

Common Qualifications

1. Applicant and both of the parents must have citizenship of the recommending nation.
(He/she must not have a Korean citizenship)
2. Applicant should be healthy enough to complete their study in Korea.
3. Applicant should promote friendship between Korea and their home nation.
(Priority is given to those who do not have any history of studying in Korea will be given priority.)

Undergraduate Qualifications

1. Applicant should be under the age of 25.
2. Applicant must have completed regular school education outside Korea.
3. Applicant must have 80 or higher GPA percentage or be within the top 10% of school evaluation percentage.

Graduate Qualifications

1. Applicant should be under the age of 40.
2. Applicant should have obtained or expected to obtain a Bachelors or Masters degree in the field of study.
3. Applicant must have acquired 80 or higher GPA percentage of his/her previous course.
4. The first priority is given to science and engineering, but the gate is wide open to any other major.

Scholarship types

Scholarship A	100%	600,000 KRW(≒ 500 USD) Accommodation fee, textbook fee, meals included
Scholarship B	100%	300,000 KRW(≒ 250 USD)
Scholarship C	100%	NA
Scholarship D	50%	NA

Undergraduate Conditions for maintaining scholarships

The scholarship will be available for eight semesters and in order to receive the scholarships the students must maintain grades higher than B+. The student must complete a minimum of fifteen credits per semester.

Graduate Conditions for maintaining scholarships

The scholarship will be available for four semesters and in order to receive the scholarships the students must maintain grades higher than B+. The student must complete a minimum of nine credits per semester.

Deadline

The deadline is due until the end of December.
