Order of the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation of 18 June 2019, No. MINBUZA-2019.3985-27, amending the order of the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation of 19 March 2019, No. MINBUZA-2019.2897.17, establishing grant ceilings under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grant Scheme 2006 and amending the order of the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation of 8 March 2018, No. MINBUZA-2018.385214, establishing a grant ceiling and policy rules for the awarding of grants under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grant Scheme 2006 (Amendment of OKP grant ceilings for the second quarter and amendment of OKP policy rules).

The Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation,

In light of Articles 6, 7 and 10 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grants Decree; and

In light of Articles 6.4 and 6.5 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grant Scheme 2006;

Hereby decrees:

Article 1

The order of the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation of 19 March 2019, No. MINBUZA-2019.2897.17, establishing grant ceilings under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grant Scheme 2006 (Orange Knowledge Programme, second quarter 2019),¹ shall be amended as follows:

A

Article 1 will be amended as follows:

1. In the heading, '€17,896' will be replaced by '€21,996,000'.

2. Subsection d. will be replaced by:

d. Grants for activities aimed at organising institutional collaboration projects: €15,050,000, which amount is allocated to 14 calls as follows:

- 1) One call of €600,000
- 2) One call of €700,000
- 3) Two calls of €750,000
- 4) Two calls of €800,000
- 5) Two calls of €1,000,000
- 6) One call of €1,050,000
- 7) Two calls of €1,100,000
- 8) One call of €1,400,000
- 9) One call of €1,800,00
- 10) One call of €2,200,000.

In this connection, if any funds are left unspent from the funds that are available for one of these calls, those funds shall be made available for applications submitted in response to the next call within the period from 1 April 2019 until 30 June 2019.

B

The Annex to the Order of the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation of 8 March 2018, establishing a grant ceiling and policy rules for the awarding of grants under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grant Scheme 2006 (Orange Knowledge Programme 2018–2022)² shall be amended as follows:

1. In **Section 1**, paragraph **1.3 Available funds** '€194,661,751' shall be replaced by '€215,131,751'.

2. In **Section 3. Customised group training courses**, in the paragraph **Group training target group** under Additional criteria for RC candidates, the second bullet shall be replaced by:

- Candidates for a refresher course must have completed an OKP, NFP, NICHE or NPT-funded course.
