Why this addendum

To grants awarded under the Orange Knowledge Programme (OKP) certain obligations and conditions apply. For the Institutional Collaboration Projects the obligations and conditions are stated in the document: Grant Obligations & Conditions for Institutional Collaboration Projects. This document however does not fully state the reimbursements for PhD students. This document is therefore a supplement to the obligations and conditions for Institutional Collaboration Projects in the Orange Knowledge Programme.

Applicable Grant Obligations & Conditions

This addendum is applicable to the Grant Obligations & Conditions for OKP Institutional Collaboration Projects version 2.0 and 3.0. and is supplementary to paragraph 5.5 (Cost Category D: PhD/master's and other training in the Netherlands/Europe) and paragraph 5.6 (Cost Category E: PhD/master's and other training local/regional).
