# GOVERNMENT GAZETTE

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### **Order of the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation of 24 September 2019, No MINBUZA-2019.4339-69, establishing grant ceilings under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grant Scheme 2006 (Orange Knowledge Programme, fourth quarter 2019)**

The Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation,

In light of Articles 6, 7 and 10 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grants Decree; and

In light of Articles 6.4 and 6.5 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grant Scheme 2006;

Hereby decrees:

#### **Article 1**

A grant ceiling of € 10,100,000 shall apply for the awarding of grants in connection with the OKP 2018–2022 for the period from 1 October 2019 until 31 December 2019 for the provision of grants for activities aimed at providing scholarships, providing training courses and organising institutional collaboration projects. This amount shall be distributed among the various types of grants as follows:

- a. Grants for activities aimed at providing scholarships for the following types of programmes:
  - 1) Short Courses: € 0.
  - 2) Master's programmes: € 0.
- b. Grants for activities aimed at providing the following types of training courses:
  - 1) Refresher courses: € 1,200,000;
  - 2) Tailor-made training courses: € 0.
- c. Grants for activities aimed at providing Tailor-Made Plus training courses: €2,700,000, which amount is allocated to six calls as follows:
  - 1) One call of €900,000
  - 2) Four calls of €400,000
  - 3) One call of €200,000

In this connection, if any funds are left unspent from the funds that are available for one of these calls, those funds shall be made available for applications submitted in response to the next call within the period from 1 July 2019 until 30 September 2019.

- d. Grants for activities aimed at organising institutional collaboration projects: €10,150,000, which amount is allocated to ten calls as follows:
- 1) two calls of € 1,200,000;
  - 2) two calls of € 1,000,000;
  - 3) three calls of € 600,000. In this connection, if any funds are left unspent from the funds that are available for one of these calls, those funds shall be made available for applications submitted in response to the next call within the period from 1 January 2020 until 31 March 2020.

## Article 2

Additional policy rules shall be announced on [www.nuffic.nl](http://www.nuffic.nl) for the calls referred to in Article 1 (c, d).

## Article 3

1. The country list schedule in the Annex to the Order of the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation of 8 March 2018, No MINBUZA-2018.385214, establishing a grant ceiling and policy rules for the awarding of grants under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Grant Scheme 2006 (Orange Knowledge Programme 2018–2022)<sup>i</sup> will be replaced by the following country list:

2. For the awarding of grants in the period referred to in Article 1, Guinea, Liberia and Sierra Leone belong to the countries included in Category A of the country list specified in the first paragraph.

## Article 4

This order will take effect on the day after the date of issue of the Government Gazette in which it is published, and will expire on 1 January 2020, with the proviso that it will remain applicable to any grants already awarded before that date.

Notification of this order shall be published in the Government Gazette.
